

#### HEARING LOOP IN THE SANCTUARY:

In order to access the Loop, a hearing aid must be programmed for the "T" setting, which can be done by a hearing aid specialist. When in the Church, the user can go to the "T" setting on their device and will be connected to the speaker system via their hearing aid.

# This weekend (11/23-24)- Second Collection: <u>Diocesan International Ministries and</u> <u>missionary trips to Guatemala</u>

Sixteen years ago, the Diocese of Charleston partnered with the Sisters of Bethany (Hermanas de Bethania, Consolatrices de la Virgen Dolorosa) of San Pedro La Laguna, Guatemala, to send missionary teams and assist in the care of children, adults, and vulnerable inhabitants of the town and its nearby villages. Guatemala is one of the poorest countries in the Western hemisphere, and in the rural Mayan territory of San Pedro, the sisters operate a Catholic school and small clinic. We proudly support this important work through a sponsorship program for students and two medical missions per year to help the community in responding to the needs of the poor.

Spiritual direction is a time-honored tradition of the Catholic Church in which a person listens and responds to God's invitation to draw closer into a relationship. The spiritual director is educated and experienced in the ways God may be moving, directly or indirectly in a person's life. In this faith-based process, the spiritual director is present to help the directee develop a greater awareness of God's personal communication, grow in closeness with God and live God's desire for his/her life through prayer, discernment, and action. The director walks as a companion on God's path, by offering holy listening skills and spiritual support. # POSITION OPENING: ST. JOSEPH CHURCH DIRECTOR OF MAINTENANCE

St. Joseph Church is seeking an experienced maintenance person for the Director of Maintenance. This position would start as Asst. Director for the first eighteen months, while training under the current Director of Maintenance. This transition is part of the position due to the complexity of the position. Under the direction of the Pastor and Business Manager, this position is responsible for maintaining the buildings, grounds and equipment of St. Joseph Church, including but not limited to the church, the school, the school recreation spaces, the office building, the rectory, the Blossom House, Columbarium and parking lots. The position is responsible for physically working on assets as well as negotiating contracts with service providers, inspecting facilities to meet standards and regulations, and coordinating renovations and updates. Candidates must have knowledge of heating and cooling systems, plumbing, electrical wiring, property maintenance, and property improvement. Candidates must be able to move items, use ladders, and meet the physical demands of such a position.
