JUDGE UPHOLDS SOUTH CAROLINA HEARTBEAT LAW

Planned Parenthood's request for an injunction against South Carolina's Fetal Heartbeat and Protection From Abortion Act was denied by Judge Daniel Coble. The Act, passed in May 2023, aims to protect unborn life after six weeks. Planned Parenthood argued the bill's language was unclear, but Judge Coble noted its intent was clear. Legal challenges followed a state Supreme Court ruling upholding the law's constitutionality in August 2023. The South Carolina Catholic Conference applauds the court's decision and hopes that the Heartbeat law will continue to save lives, since we know it has saved many already since it went into effect last fall.

ESTF RECIPIENTS FOR 2024-2025

The Education Scholarship Trust Fund awarded 2,880 scholarships to South Carolina students in its first year, receiving nearly 8,000 applications. The pilot year had stringent eligibility criteria, with only 36% of applicants qualifying. For the 2024-2025 school year, applicants had to meet specific requirements, including residency, age, income, and not being homeschooled or already receiving certain funds. Rep. Shannon Erickson proposed extending the application deadline to accommodate more families. Approximately 10% of applications were denied due to income exceeding federal poverty guidelines. The program plans to increase income eligibility to 300% and 400% of the poverty guidelines in subsequent years. The South Carolina Catholic Conference celebrates the opportunity for personalized education and hopes for universal access in the

future, advocating for broader participation in the program.

This week, Gov. Henry McMaster signed multiple bills into law in South Carolina, including the "Help, Not Harm" bill, preventing minors from accessing gender transition medications or procedures. South Carolina becomes the 25th state to enact such legislation. Gov. McMaster expressed his support on the social platform, X, emphasizing the law's aim to safeguard children and restrict public funding for such procedures. Michael F. Acquilano of the South Carolina Catholic Conference welcomed the law, emphasizing the importance of protecting children from irreversible gender transition practices.




