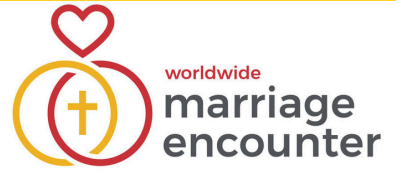
WHERE **Where are Youth Corps session?**
