

Starting in August and ending in early May. Sessions are usually once a week after school (typically from 6:00PM-8:00PM). There is also a mandatory overnight kick-off weekend in early August and two Saturday sessions (Oct Nov)



### Where are Youth Corps session?

Each session takes place in a unique location in the Midlands relating to that module (ie. art studio during Arts&Culture, local bank during Investment&Finance, etc.), and sessions are led by top community leaders in their fields.


