HEARING LOOP IN THE SANCTUARY:

In response to the needs arising from the recent hurricanes, St. Joseph's will hold a special collection for Disaster Relief on the weekend of October 26-27, 2024.

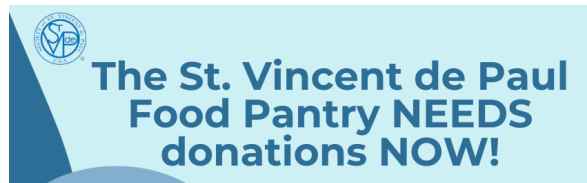

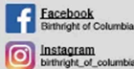

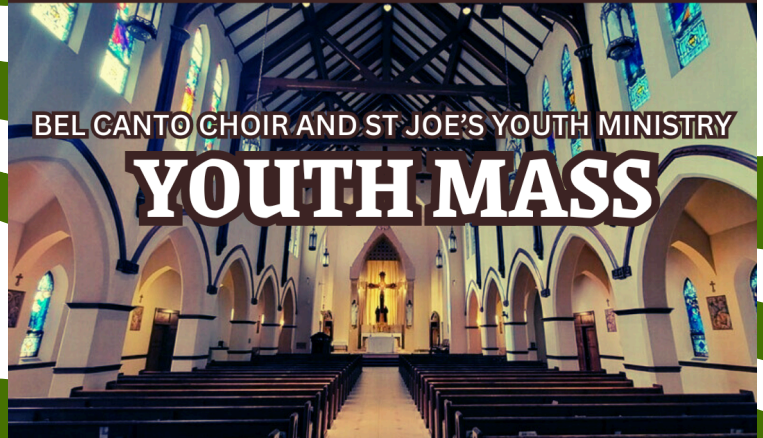
